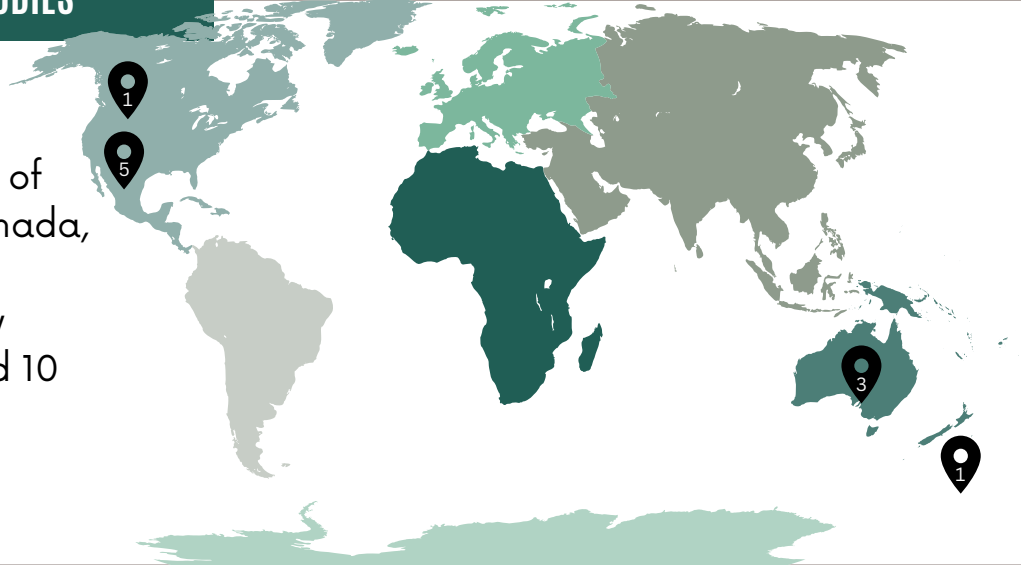


Systematic Review

Interventions addressing suicide among Indigenous adults and reporting Indigenous-specific content and involvement in the interventions

INCLUDED STUDIES

Systematic review of research from Canada, the United States, Australia and New Zealand identified 10 studies.



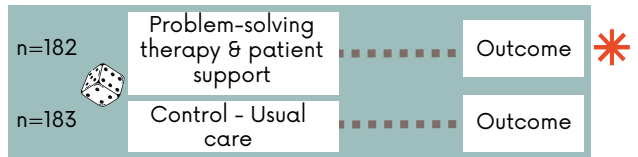
STUDY CHARACTERISTICS

Among the 10 studies including adults aged 16 years or greater or aged 16 years on average were 2 randomized control trials, 1 pre-post study with comparison and 4 without as well as 3 retrospective cohort studies.

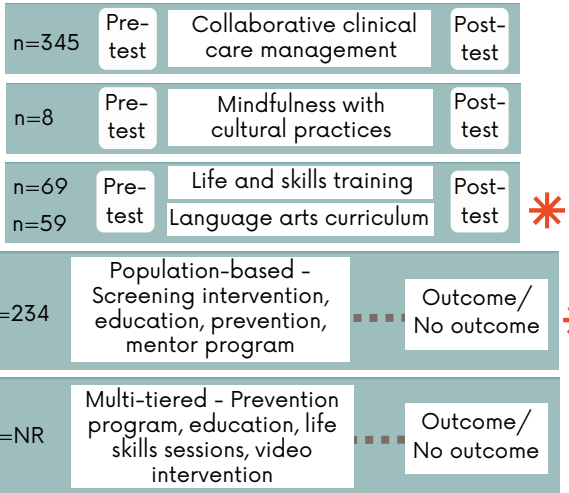

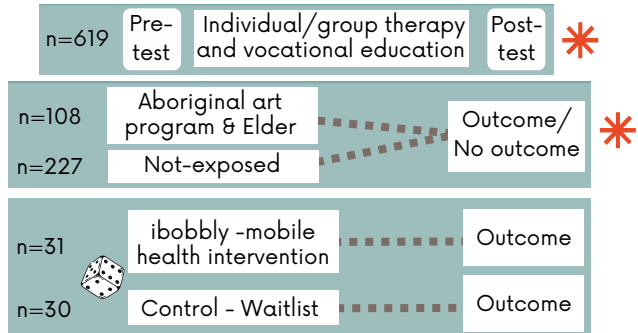

9 Studies weak

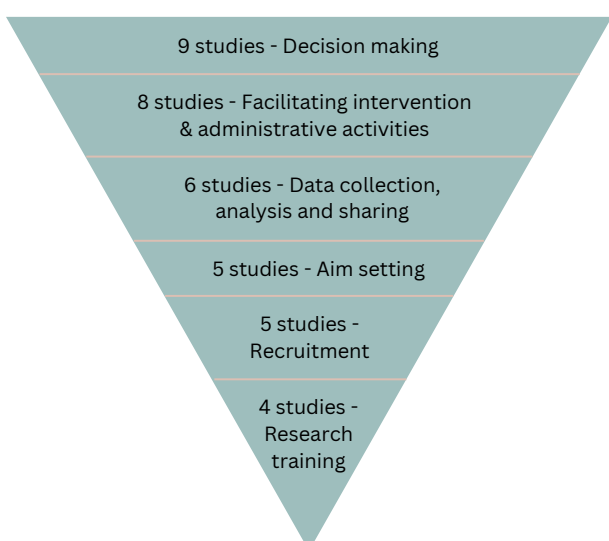
1 Study moderate - New Zealand

SUICIDE-RELATED OUTCOMES

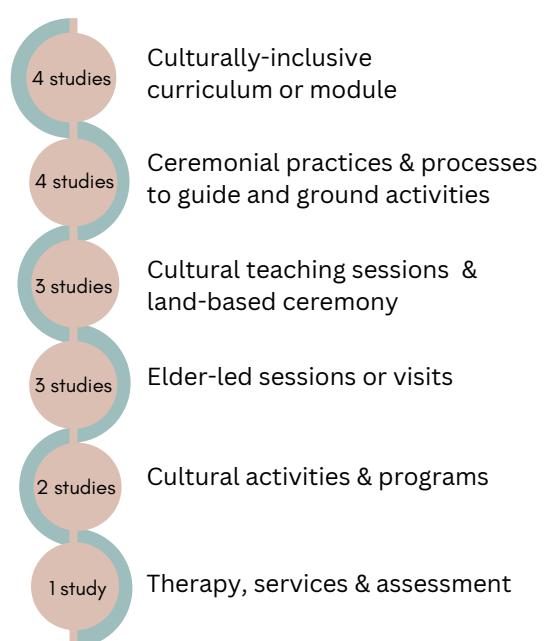
6 studies reported statistically significant reductions in suicide-related outcomes as indicated by an asterisk (*) in study characteristics.

INDIGENOUS INVOLVEMENT

Involvement was described in decision making and research activities & intervention implementation for 9 studies.



Indigenous-specific content was described for 8 studies.
